

FLIGHTS AND TRANSPORT

Ezeiza Airport: It is located 40 minutes from the city and is used for the arrival and departure of international flights.

Jorge Newbery Airport: It is used for domestic flights, although many international flights arrive at this airport located 10 minutes from the Cultural Center.

Private taxis: The airport has a large number of taxi and remise companies located at the passenger landing exit.

Approximate cost of the transfer from Ezeiza to Buenos Aires: \$45,000 (USD 35)

Approximate cost of transfer J.Newbery – City of Buenos Aires: \$15,000 (USD 10)


Minibuses: They are a cheaper alternative and depart every half hour from the airport with transfer services to major downtown hotels. www.tiendaleon.com.ar

Approximate cost of the transfer from Ezeiza to Buenos Aires: \$11,000 (USD 9)

Digital platforms: Approximate cost of the transfer from Ezeiza to Buenos Aires: \$35,000 (USD 25)

Approximate cost of the transfer from J.Newbery to Buenos Aires: \$13,000 (USD 10)

GENERAL INFORMATION

City of Buenos Aires

It is the capital of the Argentine Republic, with European architecture, offering tourists numerous museums, exhibition halls, art galleries, cinemas, and theaters.

It is the country's financial, stock market, and economic headquarters. Its commercial activity is intense, reflected in numerous stores of the world's leading brands, galleries, and shopping malls.

Its nightlife is very varied and extends well into the early hours of the morning. Nightclubs, restaurants, cafes, and many other attractions for all tastes are spread throughout the city, offering countless options for tourists.

The Buenos Aires obelisk is a National Historic Monument and a representative icon of the city.

Electric current

Throughout Argentina, alternating current is used, with a voltage of 220 volts. Hotels usually have 110-volt adapters.

Climate

Buenos Aires' climate—temperate and humid—is mild year-round, so intensely hot and cold days are rare.

Normal temperatures at this time of year range between 17° and 25°, with an average temperature of 23°.

Currency

The peso (\$) is the official currency of Argentina. Although the dollar is generally accepted, currency exchange into Argentine currency is available at banks and authorized credit bureaus. The most commonly accepted credit cards are American Express, VISA, Diners, and Mastercard.

Exchange rates may fluctuate. As of August 6, 2025, the official exchange rate against the dollar was: USD 1 = \$ 1.337

Visa

To enter Argentina, visa requirements depend on your nationality and the purpose of your trip. Citizens of many countries do not require a tourist visa for up to 90 days. If you plan to stay longer or work, or if your country requires a visa, you must apply for one at an Argentine consulate.

Vaccines

There are currently no mandatory vaccinations for entering Argentina as a tourist. However, vaccination against yellow fever is recommended if you are traveling to high-risk areas, especially the jungle regions in the north of the country.

Sure

Delegates are encouraged to consider purchasing travel insurance before arriving in the country and ensure coverage is provided throughout their stay.

Business hours

Banks and exchange offices: Monday to Friday, between 10 am and 3 pm. Commercial offices: generally from 9 am to 12 pm and from 2 pm to 7 pm. Shops and businesses: 9 am to 8 pm. Saturday hours are 9 am to 1 pm. Cafes, pastry shops, and pizzerias: they are almost always open, with a break between 2 and 6 in the morning.

Restaurants: Lunch is served from 12:30 pm and dinner from 8:30 pm. Many establishments offer fast food at any time.

Tips

It is customary to leave a 10% tip in cafes and restaurants, and to tip doormen, bellhops, and ushers.
